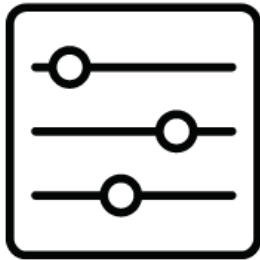

RESPONSIBILITIES

HOST RESPONSIBILITIES

- Organising the Games
- Providing suitable venues and equipment
- Recruitment, coordination and registration of international and local delegations
- Developing participant materials
- Securing insurances for the event
- Marketing, Communication & Sponsorship of the Games
- Opening & Closing ceremonies, social & physical activity programme
- Volunteers and staffing for the Games
- Reporting Games conclusions to TAFISA
- Inviting TAFISA Board Members and VIPs such as IOC, UNESCO, WHO, EU, ICSSPE, etc.
- Signing Games contract with TAFISA including budget and licence fee

TAFISA RESPONSIBILITIES

- Permanent support from TAFISA Office in Frankfurt, Germany
- Support for marketing and patronage
- Access to TAFISA's networks
- Event promotions through TAFISA's communication channels
- Sharing experience and expertise from previous events
- Selection of international delegations to participate and support invitation policy
- Assistance with programme design and development
- Consultation from TAFISA associated experts and specialists

BIDDING PROCEDURE

Step 1	<p>Opening of the bid & expression of interest</p> <p>Opening of bidding process by TAFISA. The bidding and application documents, official deadlines and guidelines to apply are widely disseminated and published on TAFISA's website. Parties thinking of hosting the 8th TAFISA World Sport for All Games send TAFISA an expression of interest letter.</p>
Step 2	<p>Submission of application</p> <p>Submission of application documents by interested parties.</p>
Step 3	<p>Online Meetings and Site Inspection</p> <p>Site inspection(s) by TAFISA, visit of venues, working meetings and high-level meetings on invitation of the bidding party.</p>
Step 4	<p>Signing of pre-contract</p> <p>Signing of pre-contract, following the receipt of application documents. The candidate is then given the title of "Official Bidder". The pre-contract will only become valid if the candidate is elected officially.</p>
Step 5	<p>Election of the Host</p> <p>The TAFISA General Assembly elects the host of the 8th TAFISA World Sport for All Games.</p>
